PARENTS' EVENING

Staff have done their best to accommodate all requests as close to the time requested as possible, and in the order in which they were received.

PARENT PAY

A growing number of Parent Pay accounts are in debt and this costs school, which ultimately has to come out of our school budget, which is already stretched.

A reminder that the account must be pre-loaded and kept in credit so that the cost of school meals or snacks can be deducted each time they are ordered by your child. If debt becomes significant, the kitchen staff are not allowed to continue to provide a meal and if funds are not available, a snack cannot be ordered.

Whilst we recognise that the cost of living is causing lots of issues currently, we must ask that you keep your ParentPay account topped up and avoid getting into debt, or provide a packed lunch for your child. Please check your Parent Pay account to make sure that the school meals and snack account has funds available.

You may also want to check whether your financial situation meets the criteria for Free School Meals and make an application for support: Apply for free school meals - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

You can set up reminders to alert you when your child's school meals band snack balance is getting low, and you can also set up regular direct debit payments to make sure that the account is always topped up.
