RECEPTION CLASS: SEPTEMBER 2024

The deadline for applications for September 2024 Reception class is midnight on Monday 15th January.

Please make sure that applications have been submitted on the Local Authority online platform. Late applications will only be considered once all other places have been allocated.

Please also ensure that supplementary faith forms are returned to school, along with baptism certificates for those who are baptised Catholic, so that we have proof of baptism (sight of the certificate will be noted, but no copy taken). Please be aware that this still applies if your child was baptised at St Joseph's as due to GDPR, we are no longer allowed to check Parish baptism registers. Without proof of Baptism, this changes the admission criteria which will be applied to your child's application.

Thank you for your support in making this process run smoothly.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

A small, but increasing number of children are not wearing correct school uniform. A reminder that parents and carers are responsible for ensuring that children come to school in the agreed uniform, which parents agreed at consultation in May 2022. Please see the list below as a reminder of our expectation.

All children are expected to wear school uniform. Please ensure all items are labelled.

Hair bobbles: navy / black / grey / white / blue gingham in summer

No jewellery is to be worn, except for a simple watch. We advise that earrings are not worn for health and safety reasons, however should you allow your child to wear earrings, only small studs will be acceptable, which must be removed for PE.

Hair styles must not be extreme, and should be appropriate and safe for school activities (long hair must be tied up).

Whilst book bags are preferred, a small rucksack can be brought to school. Rucksacks must be *small, plain and appropriate for school with minimal branding or slogans.*
